

## ISFFA Chicago Chapter Belmonte-Priebe Accounting Scholarship Program

This scholarship for college students recognizes accounting students who demonstrate strong academic performance, leadership qualities, and financial need. The scholarship was established by Gilda Priebe, a partner of Adelfia LLC, to demonstrate her strong commitment to providing educational opportunities for students in the Philippines, particularly those who graduated from high schools in the province of the Philippines who would like to pursue the CPA profession.

## **Eligibility Requirements**

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1) A high school graduate from any of the schools in the province of the Philippines.
- 2) Enrolled in a college or university taking up Bachelor of Science in Accountancy or equivalent.
- 3) Have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 3.0 (out of 4.0) or 85% equivalent.
- 4) Demonstrate achievement and financial need.

## **Scholarship Amount**

First and Second Year College Students – \$200 Third and Fourth Year College Students – \$300

This scholarship is merit based and is <u>awarded per semester to eligible students</u>. Student must meet grade point average criteria to continue to qualify. Scholarships are to be paid directly to the student, for which adequate supporting documentation will be required.

## **Instructions for First Time Applicants:**

- 1. Complete the application form (incomplete application forms will be declined)
- 2. Submit a copy of your transcript, resume, and high school diploma
- 3. If already enrolled in the college or university, copy of invoice
- 4. Recommendation letter from Dean of Accountancy or equivalent
- 5. Send in your application, including all attachments, electronically to info@chicagoisffa.org

To apply for continued scholarship for the next semester:

- 1. You must meet the qualifying (GPA) of at least 3.0 (out of 4.0) or 85% equivalent of the subjects enrolled in the previous semester paid by the scholarship
- 2. Submit upcoming semester registration (subjects and tuition/fees breakdown)
- 3. Complete the application form. Essay no longer required.

Scholarships awarded will be recognized during the ISFFA Chicago – Induction of Officers gathering and/or at the ISFFA National Conference.
